I have some minor comments that would add some clarity to the manuscript.

First of all, I prefer that authors end their introduction with the research question and the hypothesis postulated from this research.

Second, in the introduction it is preferable to refer to a universal FDA defintion of essential drugs (what is to be considered essential and what not)

Third, in the sample size section, more explanation is needed for way of sampling being followed and how the total number was calculated .

Finally, the reference for the cut off point for the ABC classification to state on what basis did the authors classify the first 20% listed drugs and so on.
