

Review of: "Land Size Class Wise Growth of Crop Diversification Index: A Case Study From Murshidabad District of West Bengal"

The paper provides informative information about the spatiotemporal changes in the crop diversification index across different land size classes in India. However, there are some limitations in the current version of the paper.

- **The abstract should include some numerical results.** In the current version, there is only one concluding sentence for the results in the abstract. Some main findings about crop diversification across land size classes could be added to the abstract. The current results in the abstract have a weak relationship with the title and the research question.
- **The rationale should be further improved.** The introduction does not explain why land size class is important in crop diversification.
- **The grammar errors should be corrected.** It will be better to use the past tense in writing the methodology and results sections.
- **The discussion is needed in a broader context.** It will be better to discuss the main findings in a broader scientific context to address the significance of the main findings for audiences outside of India.
