However, this paper also has some shortcomings.

First, this paper is flawed in its literature review of traditional domestication perspectives. Not only does it fail to organize traditional domestication perspectives, but it also fails to provide a targeted critique. If this piece of content can be added, this paper should have a substantial theoretical improvement.

Secondly, this paper lacks a logical framework for categorizing the domestication history of each species, and it is suggested that it can be differentiated according to animal, plant, and geographical regions.
