The paper lacks a comprehensive background that could provide a deeper understanding of the historical context and evolution of noise pollution in educational institutions in the Calabar metropolis. Additional information on the regulatory framework, if any, and previous studies on noise pollution in the area would contribute to the significance of the study.

The literature review is minimal and does not sufficiently explore existing research on noise pollution in educational institutions globally or in Nigeria. A more thorough review could strengthen the paper's foundation, providing a basis for the study's objectives and hypotheses.

While the paper mentions the instrumentation used for recording noise levels, it lacks details on the sampling methodology, duration of measurements, and the specific locations within the institutions where readings were taken. This information is crucial for the reproducibility and reliability of the study.
