Review of: "When the Mind Falters: Managing CEO Cognitive Decline in Leadership"

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- Impairment in cognitive abilities could be explained properly.
- The language in the introduction part could be revised; e.g., "Aging often comes with neurological diseases or psychiatry causing difficulties" doesn't make sense.
- Cognitive Decline definition is missing.
- Deterioration of cognition could be changed to Deterioration of Cognitive abilities.
- The objectives of the study are unclear.
- The use of 'she' in the introduction part is unclear.
- There are grammatical errors.
- In the Literature Review: "Physiological changes lead to cognitive impairment" is not explained.
- "Subtle cognitive impairment" doesn't explain the actual condition and symptoms.
- Cognitive resources could be defined.
- Use of informal language and incomplete sentences could be avoided and modified.
- Methodology is not clearly defined.
- What does 'treatment prev' signify?
- How did the researcher differentiate between dementia-like cognitive decline and age-related cognitive decline?
