Review of: "Stability and Synchronization of Kuramoto Oscillators"

Note: My review is based on the first section of the manuscript, which is sufficient to determine that, in its current form, the manuscript is inappropriate as a scientific publication.

The goal of the first part of the manuscript is to give a historical overview of the Kuramoto model. While such an overview was already brilliantly provided by Strogatz in Ref. 1, the goal is fair and worth the exercise. This being said, the first section lacks accuracy and clarity. As an example, the critical coupling is very quickly mentioned while it deserves a proper and thorough definition.

The major issue for me appears at Fig. 1. This figure is directly copied from Ref. 1 without citation. While the source appears in the reference list, it is very bad practice not to cite it where it is used in the text.

In view of such issues, I will not review this manuscript further before it is fixed.
