The authors raise an interesting idea for this text, as is the potential use of AI in education, tertiary in their own words. However, I think they need to keep working on both their idea and the text.

First they need to clarify what the text has to do with Nigeria. They name this country in the title, but there is no further reference in the text.

Also, in my opinion, they should define more precisely what tertiary education is and which tertiary institutions they are analyzing. They seem to refer to the University, but is it the same degree and master in their research?

And above all, they should try to organize their text according to some kind of academic article typology, clearly indicating the objectives, methodology, results... With the current format it looks like a general bibliographic review, but without greater specificity.

I encourage the authors to continue working on their text, especially providing it with a more recognizable structure, and specifying objectives, methodology and type of research.
