I congratulate the authors for writing this review. The following are my considerations.

1. The factors could be more detailed, as it seems like an overview.
2. The reasons for providing a wet or dry throat pack are not discussed. I prefer a wet one to avoid sticking of the pack to the mucosa.
3. Edema can be controlled additionally by a pressure bandage, usually after mandibular osteotomies.
4. Local pressure gauze is useful for hemostasis.
5. Local anesthesia with adrenaline is beneficial in bleeding and pain control.
6. In conclusion, there should be good suction done before and after throat pack removal.
