Introduction section:

Native chicken constitutes about 45.8-83.2% (average of this value could be more appropriate) of the total meat consumed in Africa.

Material Methods Section:

Location of the research area must be represented in degree, minutes and seconds, (for example, 40°45'11"N, 73°58'59"W)

Results and Discussion section:

The heritability estimates for body weight are presented in Table 2 below. The direct heritability for body weights of NILC were 0.51, 0.76, 0.89, 0.22 and 0.20 at weeks 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 (please add "respectively" after these values).
