The direct main aim of the study is studying the associations between direct contact with the oil and worsened health indicators after Deepwater Horizon oil spill seems to be an interesting point of view. This was based on a 12-month survey of residents of four Gulf Coast states (Alabama, Florida, Louisiana, and Mississippi) with landline telephone questionnaire as initiation action before inventorying survey data from GSPS random sample of households. All of this effort is great but as you mentioned in limitation sector all of this survey might not directly and clearly link the oil spill effect on clinical health. So, I think that you need more evidence to link these assumptions with oil spill crisis.
