Thank you for your research. The added value of the research is high. However, some issues should be addressed:

- The research objective is not fully underlined. It appears that the research attempts to accentuate the role of teleeducation in medicine, during and after the COVID-19 pandemic. Nevertheless, the structure of the research doesn't help to achieve this goal.
- 2. Although the Introduction section is relevant and adequate, the same doesn't hold for the Literature Review. The Literature Review section is mixed with the results in a way that the literature review outcome is attenuated.
- 3. The method used is not evident. It is not described how the results have been produced. If the results are based on the literature review outcome, the connection between the method and the results is not comprehensible.
