Good and useful article, but a few paragraphs/sections should be improved by including more details, modifying your citations, and verifying grammatical mistakes.

Your introduction is lacking a few details, such as at least two examples of mosquito-borne diseases that affect humans and animals, and a short description of Indonesia to justify its choice.

References/citations should be included at the end of the following sentence: These methods have not achieved maximum results.

Your citations should be improved. If the article has more than three authors, only the last name of the first author and the year of publication should be included.

References/citations should be included at the end of the following sentence: An increase in mosquito populations. In addition, insecticide resistance should be mentioned in your paragraph about the interconnectedness of human, animal, and environmental health.

References/citations should be included at the end of the following sentence: Traditional approaches to mosquito control have focused primarily on insecticides and elimination at breeding sites. In addition, there is a grammatical mistake.

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
