- 1. In the abstract, you mentioned 7 diets. However, in the method section, you mentioned 8 treatments. Please check.
- 2. In the method section, it is mentioned that <A total of 160*O. niloticus* fingerlings were used in this study with a stocking rate of 20 fish per aquarium.>, i.e., you used only 8 tanks. However, you mentioned in the abstract that the experiment was conducted with 3 replications. Therefore, 21 aquariums are necessary. Please check.
- 3. Feed formulation/compositions are not provided.
- 4. In the method section, there is a section called microbiological sample collection and analysis. However, the results should have been presented or discussed in relevant sections. Please check.
- 5. Shift the sub-sections viz., *Proximate Composition of individual feed ingredients, Proximate Composition of experimental diets, and Energy levels in the diets* from the results section to the method section.
- 6. Merge Table 3 with Table 2.
- 7. Add references for the acceptable range in Table 4.
- 8. The discussion section needs improvement, especially in reasoning through the results obtained.
- 9. Significant improvement is needed in English grammar and language.
