To begin with, the effort of the authors is appreciated. However, the following observations may be considered:

To begin with, a lot of references appear at the end of the paper, but very few have been cited in the text. This makes the paper more like an essay instead of an academic inquiry.

The authors do not discuss the background of the study and straight away jump to the experiment. It is important to develop the context, which should focus on the area that has been previously unstudied or where there is a presence of some contradictory findings in the body of literature.

The gaps in the literature and potential contributions need to be highlighted in greater detail.

The study involves the manipulation of three variables and their effect on the dependent variable. How was this achieved? This needs explanation, as well as how it was treated statistically.

The research operationalization needs to be explained to help readers grasp how the study was carried out.
