In order to transform this contribution to a research paper, I would recommend to perform analyses with concrete data sets which originate either from a qualitative or a quantitative study. In the first case, interviews with affected academicians could be performed. In the latter case, publication data could analyze publication data and investigate to what extent the order of authors has indeed changed after the introduction of the UGC regulations in India in 2009. However, I would also find a study very interesting, which analyzes the publication data of authors with an unnatural high publication record. Probably, such a study would even find also other reasons than those mentioned in this opinion paper.
