The consensus opinion of all the reviewers is that there is no justifiable scientific reason to split light or a single photon velocity into two components, as proposed by the author. The v2 of this manuscript has presented nothing new to alter my opinion.

That electromagnetic waves exhibit also particle-like property or different color light carrying different power does not justify the two-components treatment.

Too much emphasis is given to the undergraduate physics textbooks as reference. What is presented is unlikely to have any new application, as claimed.
