Second: It would have been better if the sample size of the study were larger.

Third: For Table 1 at the income level, please adjust the numbers because the total is 279 instead of 290, and I believe there is no harm in publishing after adjusting this number.

Additional comments:

- The study provides valuable information on the prevalence of selected NCDs among PLHIV in Uganda.
- The study methodology is sound, and the findings are well-presented.
