

Review of: "The Ancient Indian Knowledge System and the Medical Sciences"

The topic reviewed in the article is highly relevant. I would like to give the following suggestions

- It would be better to rethink about the topics to be reviewed under the title. While reading the title the reader will expect
 a review of different ancient Indian medical systems existed or traditional concepts about medical science in one or
 more branches. But in this article, only nadipariksha, ayurveda, veda and mental health have been dealt which seems
 to be insufficient.
- The introduction of the article may be restructured by giving a background of the topic. Of course Ayurveda is the ancient system of Indian medicine hence more importance may be given to highlight the ayurvedic concepts regarding health and disease rather than giving undue importance to nadipariksha in the introduction.
- It would be better to reframe about the matters discussed in the subsequent paragraphs. For example the subtitle The vedas ends with researches of ICMR which seems to be irrelevant there but can be included as a separate paragraph. In Chronology.. fever has been mentioned which looks odd.

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
