

Review of: "Connection Between Climate Change and Wildfires"

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The paper deals with the role of climate change and wildfire. As indicated by the authors, it is a review paper. I went through the whole paper, and I can say that it lacks major parts to be considered a journal paper. The references and papers reviewed by the authors are very limited. The details are also limited and could be found in a normal search on the net.

Interestingly, the paper claims that 90 percent of fires in the USA are caused by humans (and not climate change) and thus there should have been enough emphasis on this aspect as well. From a climate change point of view, and considering rising temperatures and altering rainfalls, the authors should have also discussed the GCM models and the possible scenarios in their review. Nevertheless, as I mentioned earlier, the review is very limited on the subject itself.

I could not see any statistics related to the subject. The authors could provide a time-based statistic of wildfires and discuss the role of each part in those fires.
