

Review of: "Italian Position Paper (SIPMO-SICMF) on Medication-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (MRONJ)"

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This new Italian Position Paper (SIPMO-SICMF) on Medication-Related Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (MRONJ) represents an important document to fill the gaps of the recent years in terms of recommendations in MRONJ management.

The Expert panel addresses the main open questions on the subject and the relevance of the clinical practice indications that derive from it is of paramount importance to clinicians.

For instance, personalized risk assessment in cancer patients is crucial and should be planned in accordance with patients' needs prioritising the quality of life and the Panel agrees that individualization of care is essential.

It is my personal opinion that the impact of comorbidities on MRONJ management could be paradoxical and that understanding patients determinants seems to be crucial for the diagnostic and therapeutic process of MRONJ, leading to targeted interventions with the better potential; these aspects are opportunely introduced within the discussion which I appreciated.

There are some limitations that derive from the objective difficulties of establishing guidelines for the management of such a multifaceted pathology especially when referring to frail patients and about this focus researchers interested in MRONJ will be able to find in this paper interesting discussion points.
