I believe the commentary is important, especially hearing from a first hand practitioner. We need more practice based articles available to read. But the article reads more like a travelogue, listing different experiences of the writer, rather than drawing out more critical nuances of the work being done or the experiences of those caught in the systems surrounding forced migration. I would have enjoyed more of a focus on one of the many experiences, that draws out more detail and illustrates the difficulties of practicing with this population more acutely. Also, some of the photos felt like they were more tourist-like pictures which feels a little unsensitive if the focus is supposed to really be on the injustices and struggles refugee populations confront.
