The scientific name is mentioned in full in the document. Please abbreviate the genus name after its first mention in the text.

In the discussion section, it is crucial to highlight the potentially toxic components of the plant and their potential effects.

As the main conclusion from the work, it would be logical to connect the study's findings to the future objective of the investigation, to demonstrate the compatibility of your results with the ultimate goal of the manuscript.
