This manuscript addresses road traffic crash mortality data collection processes, which is a theme quite relevant and interesting. However, some issues can be improved.

- I suggest restructuring the Introduction; for instance, the goal should be stated earlier in the text. Also, the literature review should be summed up in a section.
- Section 3.2 mentions *in-depth interviews*, but the size of the sample is not mentioned;
- I suggest presenting the CRVS Data (Section 4.3) in greater depth.
- Recommendations (Section 6) should come before the conclusion (Section 5).
- Through the reading of the manuscript, I did not see how the content provides valuable insights for policymakers, researchers, and practitioners in addressing the challenges in RTC mortality data collection;
