The article topic is intereting. However, I found the article is very vague and there are many points should be adjusted.

Starting with an abstract, it's very unclear why this research comes into focused, what methodologies employed and its results. Major contributions are not also stated.

For the Introduction, it's hard to follow the main points the statement of problems and significance of the study. It should be rewritten with better cohesive and organised information.

In terms of Part 2, it's good to have background of the TDTU university. The points are, however, diverse and not too sure to what extent these related to the studied points. The authors should make the studied points clearer.

Again for the results, the data is too short and doesn't have detailed explanation of why the number of teaching and research staff from different Faculties are represented and what do these results imply.

In the Discussion, I somewhat understand that the authors would like to present the "international' image of the university linking to the Result. As the rusults are very limited, this entirely affects the way in which the authors discuss the results effectively.

Furthermore, for language, cohesion and organisation overall, the authors should rearrage, use clearer sentences, have a well links between paragraphs (e.g. Paragraph 3 and 4) and have grammartical check such as singualr and plural nouns.

In sum, this paper needs a major revision with a clear statement of problem, research objectives, methodologies, analytical approaches for the discussion and contributions of the study.

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
