Which populations had a higher stress value? The working conditions in private and government establishments are not the same. For example, some private institutions have a poor salary package despite the high workload and limited flexibility, while in government establishments, the package may be better with some insurance benefits. The same is true with the fee structure for students, which may make the students stressed. What about the difference in sexes? You have not provided any details.
