Dear authors, I would like to make some remarks:

- The use of English should be improved (especially the sentences I put in handmade red brackets should be rephrased)
- There is no literature review! What has been written by other researchers in this field? What has been done in other countries?
- Your work seems to me to be a report written after a study by a consulting firm, rather than a publication. More
 specifically, you describe a methodology (very vague on several points) that does not seem to be scientifically
 meaningful.
- An example of the vagueness of your description is the three bullet points on page 9. Also, I get the impression that
 you are addressing people who are familiar with the entire subject, whereas you are addressing people who need to
 understand each step of the process and, more importantly, take away concrete ideas to apply in their universities (or
 teaching institutions) tomorrow morning.
- I did not understand if the project is already completed or if it is still ongoing.
- You use extensively semicolons (;) instead of commas (,)
