The article shows detailed overview of the research process and using control group shows thought out scientific approach. However there is no show of the concrete AR models used nor a detailed description of the teaching materials. Since this is a part of the research having the teaching materials available for review could be beneficial to understand why the null hypothesis was not rejected. It seems rather improbable to design AR system as a standalone teaching system, so I can only guess that the AR models were used as an additional tools to the traditional teaching methods. Having a clearer description with visuals would clarify how the AR models were used. This is, in my opinion, important question since it could also impact the hypothesis formulation.
