2. ethnicity was classified into three groups; participants from Chhetri and Brahmin community were classed as a relatively advantaged ethnic group, participants of households from dalit, janajatis, and others were grouped as a relatively disadvantaged ethnic community, including terai or madhesi-- why was these grouped as advantaged and disadvantaged group.
3. and less than fifty percent (44.2%) were residents of an urban municipality-- this may not be required especially after mentioning 55.8% were from rural municipality.
