This article cannot be considered a systematic investigation at all. There has been no systematic literature survey of the application of augmented reality in imparting public awareness regarding forest conservation so far. Only two namesake citations have been included in this study. In the methodology section, the images are not spatially synced to provide any idea of the area of interest. The maps are terrible, as the legend and text fonts are interfering with the map. There is no discussion on the software used or the justification for using it. There is no literature survey on how augmented reality is beneficial in promoting environmental awareness. The content suffers from poor English writing and needs substantial improvements. I frankly cannot fathom how this work will contribute to the conservation of Brazil's forests.
