Review of: "Antimicrobial Resistance Patterns of Foodborne Bacterial Isolates from HIV/AIDS Patients in Lusaka, Zambia"

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The manuscript was improved after the first review round. However, the incomplete description of methods still persists. As pointed out before, the manuscript reports data on 15 bacterial species, but the specific methods used to isolate and confirm their identity are not described. This information is critical for reproducing the study and thus, shall be provided. Moreover, the manuscript refers to data on *E. coli* isolates without having conducted any testing to identify if these isolates are pathogenic strains. The fact that patients were showing signs of gastroenteritis does not imply that these isolates were actually pathogenic. It has to be demonstrated.
