Thank you for your work. This report is very interesting and may have enlightening implications for clinical treatment, but I don't think the manuscript can be published because it has many limitations:

- 1. The description in the abstract section is vague, and the framework is not clear, such as "Initial results demonstrated the restoration of vital functions and the absence of cellular activity."
- 2. "The safety profile of glucosodiene has undergone scrutiny, revealing favorable characteristics for therapeutic application." Needs literature support.
- 3. The data of the entire treatment process of the case needs to be comprehensively compared, whether it is imaging examination, pathology, or laboratory testing.
- 4. The first dose of glucose given to the patient was not provided, and including this information is crucial for a comprehensive understanding of the treatment plan.
- 5. The conclusion is very short; please at least improve the research objectives, significance, and limitations.

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
