- 5. METHODOLOGY: "Purchase of supplement" to be replaced with 'supplement'. Kindly specify the country of manufacture, product details such as brand name, and concentration (e.g., 80% v/v). Data analysis: Kindly delete 'compatible' from the first sentence. Kindly write 'student t-test,' i.e., remove A. "p < 0.05," p should be in lower case. 'Of the mean' should be deleted from the last sentence
- 6. RESULTS: Table 2: Kindly add "statistically" to "significant." Tables 1 and 2: What do the t-test values in column 4 indicate?
- 7. DISCUSSION: Insert a reference in the first paragraph. Brzenzinski 1987 is too old; please use a more recent reference in the discussion section. Kindly write MO in full at first usage and put MO in brackets before using MO as an abbreviation in the work. Last paragraph, the first sentence: Kindly replace "depleted" with "few" and use a full stop after it, not a semicolon

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
