The paper is interesting and well written. The results have interesting implications.

I have two comments:

- The authors should explain better why they decided to measure gambling/betting behaviours especially for financial gain. I see two main problems. First, this question may be more influenced by social desirability than a general question about gambling/betting. The authors should include that in the limitations section. Second, the results may be misleading. They do not regard gambling but gambling for financial gain. The authors should be more specific in reporting the results.
- With a large sample like the one included in this study, the effect sizes of the significant relations should be discussed.
