The paper addresses a subject with contemporary relevance and significant contribution to literature, especially filling a geographic gap.

- I suggest "p-value" and "r-squared" be deleted from the list of keywords after the abstract.
- The sub-heading "Research Objectives" under Section 1 could be deleted while the content under it is rewritten in a narrative form to be one paragraph. The rewritten paragraph can be added to the Introduction without a sub-heading.
- The sub-sections under the various sections should be numbered accordingly. For example, the sub-heading "Factors affecting inflation" under section 2 should be numbered **2.1.** Please check the entire document for other unnumbered sub-sections and do the needful.
- The research gaps addressed by the work are not well articulated. It would be helpful to state these clearly in the introduction to justify why this research is being undertaken.
- The results would be more robust if GDP were regressed on more explanatory variables than just inflation. Other variables such as disposable income, FDI, interest rates, among other variables, could enhance the regression model. As it currently stands, the analysis and equation are very narrow.
- Please desist from using 1,2,3 to number bullets and lists as these are unconventional in publications. It is helpful to either rewrite these lists as paragraphs or, where applicable, put them in equation forms.

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
