

Review of: "Examining the Impact of Green Finance on Carbon Emissions in India through Energy Consumption Optimization"

The article being examined is "Examining the Impact of Green Finance on Carbon Emissions in India through Energy Consumption Optimization". The abstract looks fine, well drafted and concise and correctly pointed out the key points of the study. The Introduction looks well drafted, however it seems that the authors have made it unnecessarily complicated. The authors have mentioned 'People's Bank of India', in Introduction which is not clear what it indicates. In India, I have hardly seen or read that anything that has used 'People Bank's of India' instead of the name of the banks.

The methodology part could have been more clearly demarcated. Any section of an article needs to be marked and titled clearly. I have serious concerns about the way the paper has been drafted. It started with Introduction, moved to analytical framework, then discussed methodology in two parts (discrepancy analysis and analysis of mechanism), then moved to significance of the study and conclusion.

Every manuscript needs to have few clear sections like the main body which shall include the findings, the methodology part in a clear sub-section, the conclusion including the theoretical and managerial contributions of the study. The study has had framed good objectives and the idea was novel, but for a reader it is difficult to comprehend the findings from the study. The chronology in writing the various sub-headings have also been not maintained. Thus, to conclude the article could be made better by changing the style of writing and the way of presentation.

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
