I read your article with interest as the topic of social entrepreneurs and their financial security is important. I would like to make a few suggestions. In general, there are disconnections between paragraphs in the introduction. In addition, the sentences do not progress in a way that supports each other. For example; "For academics and practitioners in this sector, understanding the dynamics of SEI is of utmost importance", but why? Should it be supported? (Introduction)

In this section, it would be more accurate to include studies on social entrepreneurship, to determine what has been studied and to mention the model proposed by Hockerts. (The literature on social entrepreneurship)

Given the inconsistent data from previous studies, further research is needed to better understand the variables that influence SEI they said. But this is not a sufficient explanation. Furthermore, in the conclusion part, there is no discussion with other researches and there are deficiencies in revealing the difference and result from other researches.
