

## Review of: "Mobile Phone Recycling and Stockpiling Behaviour in the UAE: A Gender and Age Study"

The authors present a study investigating the mobile phone recycling and stockpilling behaviour in the UAE. A survey based method was employed. A large number of participants was involved in the study.

The authors could consider to include more information regarding the participants, e.g. how they were chosen/recruited and to provide at least basic participants' information, e.g. gender and age distribution, basic background information (e.g. education, technology acceptance and domain knowledge, ...).

Data analysis could be enhanced with some statistical approaches, determining the statistically important differences, etc. (e.g. the claim in conclusions "Women exhibited less concern about data privacy and were more likely to store multiple devices, particularly when the number of stored devices was two.").
