The discussion, neither the conclusion, seems convincing based on the presented results; outcomes should be presented in a significant manner. It is necessary to complete the discussion or to redefine the objective of the paper. The work defined in this way leaves a dilemma regarding the goal, whether the benefits of international cooperation and IPC or the role and influence of including pharmacists in health care, are analyzed.
