The title has reflected the intention and the article's topic quite well. Although, the abstract is written informatively, but it contains topo lengthy backround. The author could do more to explain what methodology is (data collection, sample, sampling technique, research tools) and highlights the study's contribution and implication for policy makers. The introduction is very short that it has not answered the question why this research is important. The introduction must clarify the nature of the problem, what has been studied in previous academic literature on the topic, and the real gap in knowledge. In addition, how this work addresses this research gap. I advise updating the introduction to include the research conducted on the topic and the research gaps.
