The manuscript's title "Improving agriculture and food security in Africa: Can the one health approach be the answer?" provides the necessary insights into what was discussed in the paper.

This is an interesting paper to read and it touches a very significant issue faced in the sub-Saharan African region (particularly, food insecurity), and how the *one health* approach can be applied to resolving such issues. I commend the authors for the efforts put into the study.

I have read the previous reviewers' comments, they have already made very insightful comments. However, I have some minor comments that could be useful for improving the paper. The paper is a review article but it is missing the methodology part. For instance, what review method was used (hermeneutic or systematic literature review?), what process was followed to identify the paper used in the review; these are areas that I believe the authors could improve the paper. I will encourage the authors to try and restructure the paper to include the methodology, particularly detailing the procedures followed in the selection of the literature. In addition, the result and discussion sections should follow accordingly. Finally, the conclusion should provide a synthesis of the key findings and highlight the very important contributions of the paper (and do not forget to state possible limitations and future research).

These are my comments. I hope the authors find them relevant and useful.
