- 1. it would be better to mention about knowledge, attitude and practices on the invalid vaccine doses among the parents in the objectives.
- 2. It would be better to include "Parental Attitudes Towards the invalid vaccine doses."
- 3. How defines the "proper knowledge about the number of vaccinations in the Government immunization programs"?
- 4. It would be better to explain how outcome variables are created "Immunization knowledge (Percentage) and "immunization practice (Percentage)".
- 5. 3. It is not clear in methodology how to measure the invalid vaccine doses. It would be better that the results mention about the practices on invalid vaccine doses among the parents. It would be better to include the results of how much proportion of each vaccine received were invalid according to the "operation definition of invalid dose"

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
