Review of: "Human Health Risks from Textile Chemicals: A Critical Review of Recent Evidence (2019-2025)"

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This is a general review article on health risks from chemicals in textiles. It is generally well done, but it needs more emphasis on microfibers as a major vector for human exposure to the chemicals in textiles. This exposure is mostly via inhalation, but potentially also dermal. This is missing and should be included in figure 1. I also suggest that the section that deals with microfibers be moved up to precede the sections on different types of toxic chemicals found in textiles.
