

Review of: "Sustainable Agriculture and Climate Resilience in Türkiye: A Comprehensive Analysis"

The manuscript addresses an interesting topic: that of climate change and how agriculture should tackle the problems related to this issue in Turkey. However, the manuscript has a poor structure, repeatedly using the same ideas. A major revision is needed to organize the ideas and then develop them without repeating information. The manuscript needs to flow better from the fundamentals to the conclusions to be engaging for readers, whether or not they are experts in the subject.

The manuscript lacks references to support the presented data, both for the text and for tables and graphs. It is recommended to summarize the introduction and the section "Agricultural Targets of Turkey's National Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan 2011-2023." At the end of the introduction, the information can be summarized by indicating the sources in a table. The section on agricultural targets should be a summary of a single article; I believe it should be summarized, highlighting the most important ideas to emphasize the study's objectives, and additional information from other sources is required.

All figures and tables should be cited in the text and listed in order of appearance. Original sources should be indicated, and they should be up to date until 2023, or at least 2022. Excessive use of bullet points should be avoided, as this is an exception in manuscripts.

It is suggested to add a discussion of the challenges and how this has been addressed in other nations. A comparison would be interesting. Conclusions could be drawn from this comparison.

Overall, in my opinion, the article is not publishable and should be completely rewritten.
