A chemotherapy regimen consisting of oral etoposide that may be used in the treatment of adult medulloblastomas; supratentorial primitive neuroectodermal tumors (PNETs); anaplastic gliomas/glioblastomas; adult intracranial and spinal ependymomas (excluding subependymomas and myxopapillary ependymomas); thymomas and thymic carcinomas; and ovarian, fallopian tube, primary peritoneal, small cell lung and testicular cancers.
