Why were these subjects selected for the study? Details of the acute toxicity study in the methodology section is sparse. What characterestics were expected at the end of the acute toxicity assay?

The micrographs of the kidney are not clear and the magnifications are not as indicated. Different segments are shown for each group and this makes comparism difficult. The areas that are referred to as degeneration in figure 3 is not obvious.
