

Review of: "Probabilistic Assessment of the Heavy Metal Pollution in Debrecen's Topsoil"

I have reviewed the manuscript titled "Probabilistic Assessment of the Heavy Metal Pollution in Debrecen's Topsoil," and these are my comments.

- 1. The paper has been well written and generally contributes to the body of existing knowledge.
- 2. The citation in the text should be relooked at. For example, Yang et al., 2019, should be Yang et al., 2019.
- 3. Some alien text has been introduced in the manuscript. Refer to paragraph 1 under Introduction.
- 4. Figure 1 is missing from the manuscript.
- 5. Some references cited in the text are not present in the reference list. Also, the referencing style used is not consistent.
- 6. For research like this, the pH of all the samples should be provided. At a certain pH, heavy metals are most likely to dissolve in water, and it is therefore important that the pH is included for all samples.
- 7. It is suggested that the authors include a dendrogram in the analysis. A cluster diagram will reveal which of the heavy metals are related to each other.

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
