In general, I think the article's theme of "Adopting the UTAUT model to understand academic use of emerging technologies among Moroccan nursing students" to be interesting and relevant. Although the COVID-19 pandemic has been proclaimed over, its aftereffects can still be seen in several sectors, including education, where students enrolled in courses with a substantial practical component have been affected. In this regard, this study is significant for professionals in understanding the variety of emerging technologies that can be used to improve the performance of online learning in nursing courses.

The background comes from recent literature and discusses the topic's significance and relevance. The review of literature provides an adequate theoretical framework. However, it would be useful to include a section discussing existing models of technology adoption and use (such as UTAUT2) and why this was selected for the study. I also suggest that the hypotheses be fully defined in this topic, which is labeled "Literature review and hypotheses development."

It would be interesting to know about the statistical analysis program.

The discussion is well developed and based on recent studies. It includes the main limitations and future lines of research. However, I believe that the main findings in the first topic of discussion may be developed and explained more thoroughly.

The article's writing and references should be improved.
