There are several points that should be considered: 1. The text needs major English revision, especially in the Discussion section. There are several grammar/syntax/typo errors, as well as scientific errors. 2. More references are needed to support the observations. 3. Although the basis of the treatment is the Warburg effect, no substantial explanation is provided.
