There is a discrepancy in the Study Title and Objectives; they both should be inline with each other. While the title is about the effectiveness of the vaccine, the objective was to analyze the demographic characteristics, vaccination timing, and associated factors influencing the persistence or onset of long-COVID-19 symptoms among patients. Title and Objective should align with each other.

Methods employed to achieve objectives are not properly defined; thus, results could not be validated. It is not clear what the authors wish to study: vaccination effectiveness or demographic characteristics. Both will need a separate set of methods and investigations. So it is advised that the authors should make up their minds and employ methods for the same.
