The study concerns the measurement of ambient air quality at various spots and measurement stations at Lead City University, located in Ibadan, Nigeria. While the Introduction and Methodology sections are generally satisfactory, more improvements can definitely be made to the Results and Discussion section, both in terms of content and language. The authors have made attempts to compare the results of this study with the results of other studies. However, the language used needs to be more specific, since there are several instances where the authors speak of other studies and only refer to those studies in the most vague terms, such as "another urban area," which does not help with improving the clarity of the language and discussion. Furthermore, the discussion that has been carried out is rudimentary. Surely there have been other studies concerning ambient air quality measurements in other universities worldwide. The authors can discuss their results by comparing them to other studies on ambient air quality which have been carried out in other countries, which are plentiful. The Results and Discussion section for this study, therefore, can definitely be improved and expanded upon considerably. Another point is that the Results and Discussion section can be divided into further subsections, which would improve and make the discussion more focused.
